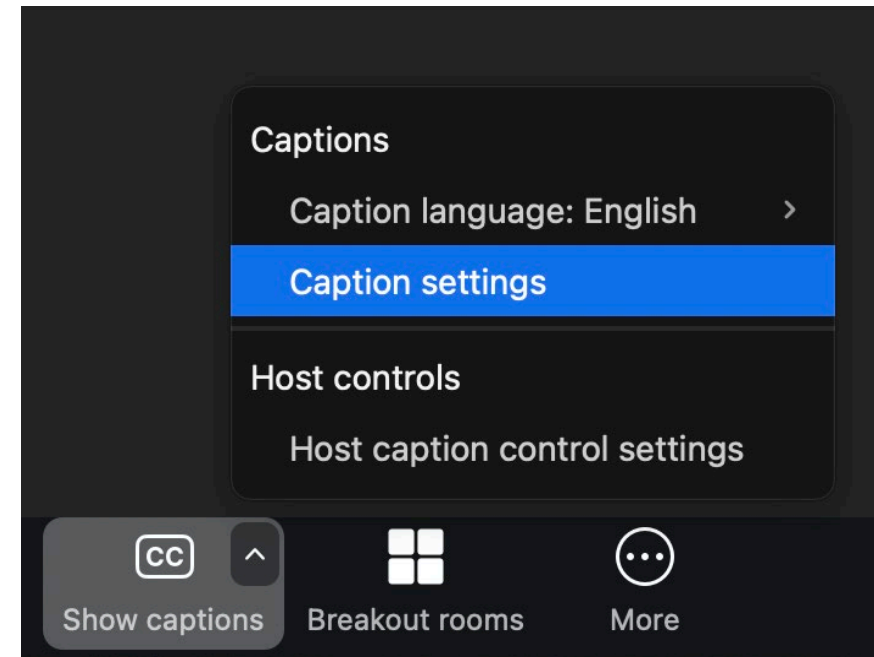

Accessibility

- **Keep chat use to a minimum if you are able**
- **Captioning: CART Captioner providing captions**
 - **To view captions:** Click the 'CC' or 'Show Captions' button at the bottom of your Zoom screen (it may also be under the 'More' button depending on your device.)
 - **To adjust font size and color:** click the carrot or 'up' arrow ^ and 'Caption Settings.'



Accessibility, continued

- **ASL interpreters** will be spotlit/readily visible on your screen while they interpreting.
 - In case of tech issues, you can pin the interpreters on your screen by clicking the three dots on the right of the ASL interpreters' screens and pressing 'Pin.'
 - If you hear the ASL interpreters speak, they are interpreting for someone who is speaking ASL.

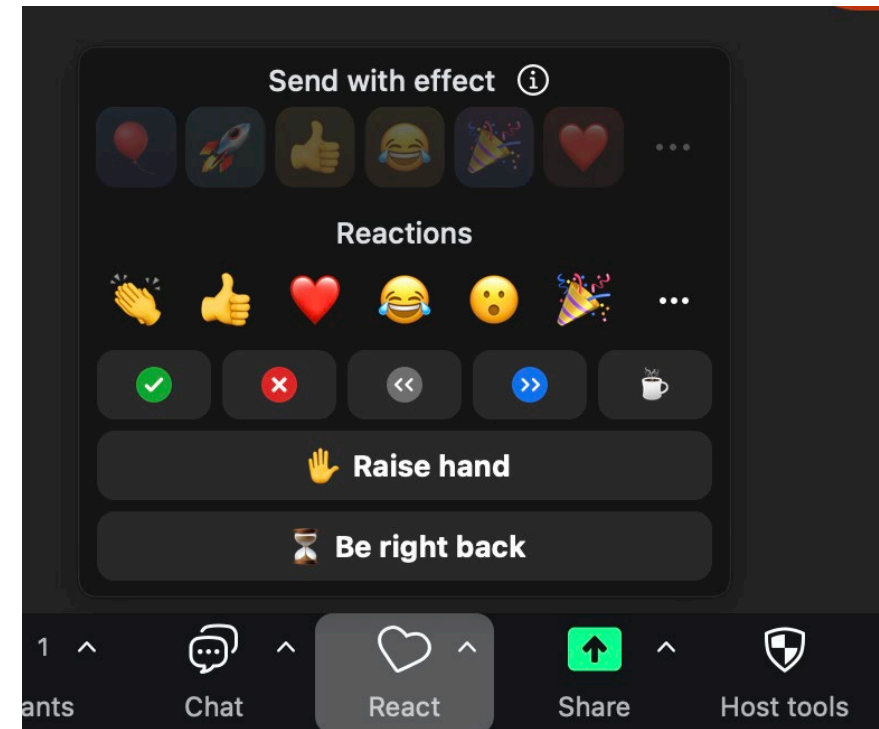

- **Mute/unmute** by pressing the microphone button at the bottom left of your screen. If joining by phone, dial *6 to unmute/mute yourself.

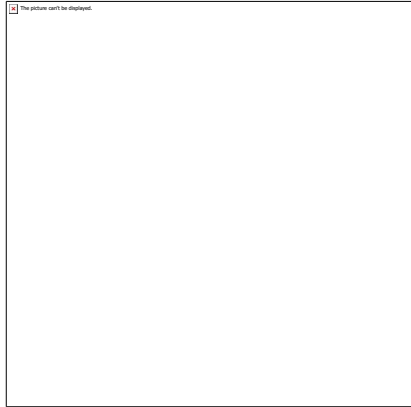

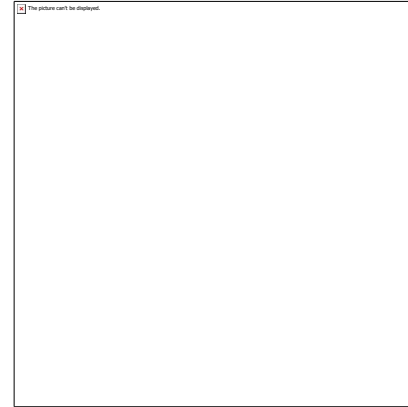

- REV UP MA is a statewide coalition of organizations and individuals. We:
 - Educate people with disabilities about voting rights
 - Advocate for accessible voting processes

 - Encourage civic engagement of people with disabilities
